

**Ordinance Number 01-2019 Town of Mekan Establishing  
Split shifts for election officials.**

**STATE OF WISCONSIN**

**Town of Mekan, Marquette County**

The Town Board of the Town of Mekan, Marquette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.7.30(1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

A. Pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes, there is hereby established one set of election officials to conduct all elections of the Town of Mekan which shall consist of seven election inspectors. However, the Town of Mekan Clerk shall have the power to limit the number of election officials. The Clerk shall determine in advance of each election whether the number of election officials for such election should be reduced from the number prescribed by the Wisconsin Statutes, and if such a reduction is so determined, the Clerk shall further redistribute duties among the remaining officials.

B. Because 7.30(1), Wis. Stats., allows for the creation of alternate or two sets of election officials to work at different times on election day, the Town Board authorizes the Town Clerk the selection of alternate and/or two sets of election officials to staff the polls on election day.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
