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
AGREEMENT


WHEREAS, the Town of MECAN (hereinafter referred to as "the Town") and Marquette County (hereinafter "the County") desire to cooperate in obtaining information to be used in the preparation of Comprehensive Plans; and, WHEREAS the County has the resources to conduct a mail survey of all landowners in a format as set forth in the attached Exhibit A;


THEREFORE the Town and the County agree as follows:

1. The Town accepts the form of the survey as is set forth in Exhibit A.
2. The U.W. Madison-Testing and Evaluation Center through National Computer Systems will produce and publish the survey.
3. The County will by mail the survey by first class mail to every landowner found within the geographical limits of the Town.
4. The County shall include a return first class postage paid envelope with every survey mailed.
5. The County shall engage University of Wisconsin-Madison to provide tabulation and analysis services of the returned surveys. The return first class postage paid envelope, provided by the County, shall bear a direct return address of Marquette County-U.W. Extension Office.
6. The County shall compile all responses to open ended questions and then forward all returned surveys to the U.W.-Madison Testing and Evaluation Center for tabulation and analysis of the remaining responses.
7. The Town and the County agree to the following timelines for conducting the survey:
 - a. All surveys shall be mailed to the landowners by or before: June 15, 2002
 - b. The deadline set forth in the foregoing survey for its return to the U.W. Extension Office shall be: 18 days from the date mailed
8. The costs for conducting the survey shall be distributed using the following distribution formula:
 - a. The Town shall pay 55% of all costs incurred by the County within 30 days after being billed for the same.
 - b. The County shall bear 45% of all costs incurred in addition to providing labor for mailing the survey and compiling open-ended responses.
9. All information obtained by the survey or by the tabulation and analysis conducted by the U.W. Madison may be used either by the Town or by the County in the preparation of Comprehensive Plans or other appropriate business.

The Town accepts and agrees to the terms of the AGREEMENT on motion duly made, seconded and approved at a regular business meeting of the Town conducted April 9th, 2002.

RESOLUTION

**AGREEMENT WITH TOWN OF MECAN AND MARQUETTE COUNTY
FOR A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MULTI-
JURISDICTIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Mecan Board of Supervisors acknowledges the requirements of Wisconsin's Comprehensive Planning Legislation including the adoption of the plan (s. 66.1001, Stats.), the benefits of comprehensive planning, and funding that would be awarded by the Wisconsin Department of Administration to financially assist Marquette County and participating communities in preparation of the comprehensive plan;

AND WHEREAS, the development of the *Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan* requires a financial contribution of \$2000.00 from the Town of Mecan;

AND WHEREAS, a series of meetings have been recently held throughout the County by county staff and their consultant which discussed the planning process and community responsibilities, gathered public input, provided information and answered questions relative to the planning process;

AND WHEREAS, as part of participating in the Marquette County multi-jurisdictional planning process the Town of Mecan will receive an individual planning document for review and adoption which addresses the requirements as specified under Wisconsin's Comprehensive Planning Legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mecan Board of Supervisors hereby agree to participate in the development of the *Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan* in cooperation with other communities within their region and Marquette County pursuant to Wisconsin Statute s. 66.1001.
