March 13th 2018 Town of Mekan Regular Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
Present Michael Raddatz, Brandon Frazer, Nancy Reuter, Caroline Gemoll and
Valorie Schable. Opened with Pledge of Allegiance by Michael Raddatz.

Minutes of February 13th, 2018 monthly meeting read by Caroline Gemoll,
motion to approve minutes by Nancy Reuter, 2nd by Brandon Frazer. Passed

Treasurer's report read by Valorie Schable, motion to put the treasurer's
report on file by Mike Raddatz, 2nd by Brandon Frazer.

School board candidate Chuck Harsh presented for School Board election coming
up Chuck gave insite of why he is running, Chuck has been in Montello all his
life and is looking to get new ideas to the school board. He has been with
the school for 19 years as High School principal and is looking to have school
continue but with more honesty and accountability to the public.

Montello School District Rick director of buildings and grounds working on
improvements and Liz Olson Grade school principal. Rich gave brochures to
everyone. State that there are 4 projects that need to get done that will
cost 3.7 million. 1st is the roof. Rick explained what needs to be done and
replace he offered a tour to anyone that wants one. Questions were posed that
the roof was to have been repaired with last referendum. Rick nor Liz could
confirm this as they were not here at that time. Liz discussed the improvement
with the grades. Rick stated that they have to go through CESA to manage the
project. CESA will be charging 4%. Liz stated this is about 47 cents per 1000
per month and they would not have to come back for referendum until 2023.
School taxes has gone up 3.9% Mike gave update on school rating Montello
School is 89 from the bottom of 620 and with 10 average kids per class this
should be higher. Liz stated that proficiencies have increased. The big
question is why has the building repairs been neglected this long. No families
moving in due to no housing and no jobs. Brandon Frazer stated that Due to
the distrust in the school board on how these funds will be appropriated that
maybe we should start small and just ask for the roofing repair and then once
the people see that the funds were actually used to do the roof repair would
be more open to the additional funds. School board ended presentation and left
meeting.

Mike nominated Tom Breiling to be the alternate appointed to Board of Review.
Nancy Reuter 2nd, Passed.
