

Town of Mekan Regular Monthly Meeting -February 9th, 2021 1561 Evergreen Montello WI 53949 at 6:00 p.m.

February 9, 2021 Town of Mekan Regular Meeting called to order at 6:05pm with the Pledge by Brandon Frazer . Present Brandon Frazer, Tom Breiling, Caroline Gemoll and Valorie Schable, David Evert, David Frosch and Jesse Schable.

Minutes from January 12th, 2021 Regular meeting were read by Caroline Gemoll. Motion to approve minutes by Brandon Frazer, 2nd by Tom Breiling. Passed.

Valorie Schable read treasurer's report. Motion to put Treasurer's report on file by Tom Breiling, 2nd by Brandon Frazer.

Hometown insurance Jesse Schable gave overview of insurance policy changes and additions and explained the increase in insurance. All townships saw an increase in policy costs. Review of information that we changed voting machines the amount will lower slightly at this point went from 2 machines to one machine. Jesse wanted the model number and will see if the amount will change due to this. Caroline gave information to Jesse on the election machine. Brandon made a motion to approve the towns Insurance of Hometown Community pending the updated prices for the election machine, 2nd by Tom Breiling.

Variance David Evert & Debra Evans this is a container that is on a lot that is across the street from a lot with a cottage and wants to have a storage unit. County stated that they cannot have buildings on vacant lots and are looking to combine the lots. Also wants to have a storage unit on the lot. The storage unit is not in compliance with zoning and the county stated that they would need to have roof and siding on the container. He wanted the town to approve information. Discussion about when the improvements will be done. The town is ok with combining the lots into one. Motion to ok with stipulation that container is sided and roofed by June 15th or removed. Brandon will draft a letter to the county for the February 25th zoning meeting. Motion by Brandon Frazer to approve special exemption for David Evert based on construction done on the unit by June 15 or remove it, 2nd by Tom Breiling.

Litigation update none -Will table the culvert ordinance till March meeting.

Adams Columbia Electric Easement Waiver letter for work needed to clear power lines. Motion to approve easement by Brandon Frazer, 2nd by Tom Breiling.

David Frosh was at the meeting to pick up overpayment of property taxes that was involved with a mix up of parcels and payment from the escrow agent.

Caroline advised the board that she did have election training and that Mike Raddatz did attend the training.

Insurance check was made out to Hometown Insurance for full amount but with the election machine change it may lower slightly. Will pay and have insurance refund any overpayment.
