May 11th, 2021 Town of Mekan Regular Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.  
Present Michael Raddatz . Brandon Frazer, Tom Breiling, Caroline Gemoll, and  
Valorie Schable.

Minutes from April 20th, 2021 Regular meeting were read by Caroline Gemoll.  
Motion to approve minutes by Tom Breiling, 2nd by Brandon Frazer. Passed.

Valorie Schable read the treasurer's report. Motion to put Treasurer's report  
on file by Brandon Frazer, 2nd by Tom Breiling.

Sealed bids for mowing at town hall

Received 3 bids, Joshua Schwarart, Bill Gemoll and Lawn Care Contract Service  
LLC. Lowest bid came in with Lawn Care. Motion to accept bid for Lawn Care  
Contract Service LLC, to cut the town hall grass by Brandon Frazer, 2nd Tom  
Breiling.

Roads- Mike gave a list of roads that need to be repaired. Will also need  
mowing that is 12ft wide and there should be 2 cuttings by June 1st and  
September 1st.

Roads designated to be worked on this year: Garden Ln \$13000, 22nd Dr (south  
of Fox Ct) \$7500, Franks Dr, Lotus Dr, Ronald Ct, Walters Ct \$22000, 22nd Ln  
Patch and paver patch \$77000.

American Recovery act funds, Valorie had questions on personal property tax  
delinquencies if the owner was having trouble due to covid to pay delinquent  
property taxes. This would only be the 2020 tax year. Mike stated that WTA  
sent an email with a link that was 150 pages of uses that the funds can be  
used.

WTA meeting Mike, Caroline and Valorie attended the meeting. Most of the  
discussion was on the American Recovery funds and how they may be able to be  
used. Possibly to get better internet or fiber optic to the town hall and all  
town of Mekan residents. Also we must be very specific on any uses of the  
funds and we will need to keep good records. Mike gave the DUNS number to  
Caroline that will be needed to receive any covid 19 funds.

Open book report - Caroline advised that 3 people came in for review.

Zoning - Mike asked about building permits. It was stated that there was  
a porch put up. Permits were issued by the county, but not the town. One  
porch and one Garage in Duck Inn. Tom will check with owners and Caroline  
will issue invoices.

Correspondence - June 2nd Fire Meeting. Caroline advised that the Department of Revenue changed their website, on where to file. There is a meeting that Caroline will attend. All reports are filed on this site.

Mike stated that the County will start on Hwy C.
