American Recovery act funds, Valorie had questions on personal property tax delinquencies if the owner was having trouble due to covid to pay delinquent property taxes. This would only be the 2020 tax year. Mike stated that WTA sent an email with a link that was 150 pages of uses that the funds can be used.
