Shortly after receiving my letter to you dated October 19, 2000, you called me to discuss the situation regarding the small pine trees (your estimate of about 150 trees) that were planted on the Town right-of-way of Fish Avenue. You mentioned that the DNR Forestry manager told you it was OK to plant them where you did.

Having gone over the whole situation with you on the phone, we came to a verbal agreement that you would transplant the one row nearest the road to another location. In view of all of the facts in the case and the big job that it will be, we agreed that the work should be accomplished prior to our Fall of 2001 mowing. We also agreed that if any trees that are presently planted within three mowing swath (about 15 feet from the road edge) are still standing when we do the Fall of 2001 mowing, the mower operator will be authorized to cut them along with other vegetation.
