ORDINANCE NO. 79-01

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE OFFENSES AGAINST THE PUBLIC PEACE AND GOOD ORDER IN THE TOWN OF MECAN, WISCONSIN.

The Town Board of the Town of Mecan, Marquette County, Wisconsin, being duly assembled, does ordain as follows:

Section 1, Offenses Against State Laws Subject to Forfeiture. The following statutes defining offenses against the peace and good order of the Town of Mecan, County of Marquette, Wisconsin, are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the municipality provided the penalty for commission of such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture imposed under Section 4 of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Littering Prohibited No person shall throw any glass, refuse or waste, filth or other litter upon the streets,, alleys, highways, public parks or other property of the town or upon any private property or upon the surface of any body of water within the town.

Section 3. Penalties. (1) Any person who shall violate any provision of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine or forfeiture provided in the statute adopted by reference, including any violations or increases for subsequent offenses. In addition to any penalty imposed for violation of sec. 943.01, any person who shall cause physical damage to or destroy any public property shall be liable for the costs of replacing or repairing such damaged or destroyed property. The parent or parents of any unemancipated minor child who violates sec. 943.01 may also be held liable for the cost of replacing or repairing such damaged or destroyed property in accordance with sec. 895.035, Wis. Statutes.

(2) For any violation of Section 2 of this ordinance, any person convicted of such violation shall be subject to a penalty, which shall be as follows:

(A) First offense - Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of Section 2 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00 together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

(B) Second Offense - Penalty. Any person found guilty of violating Section 2 of this ordinance who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same section within one year shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 not more than \$500.00 for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed 6 months.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Mecan, on the 1st day of MAY, 1977
