ORDINANCE NO. 89-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

Ordinance No. 71-1 dated June 16, 1971 is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

The Town Board of the Town of Mecan, Marquette County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows: The discharge of firearms of any nature, or pellet guns, in that portion of Sections 20,21, and 22, Township 15 North, Range 11 East, Town of Mecan, South of Fox Court and County Trunk Highway C and East of Twentieth Court, if extended to Lake Puckaway, is hereby prohibited.

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provision of this Ordinance shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$20.00 and the costs of collection, and in default of the payment of the forfeiture and the costs of collection, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Marquette County, Wisconsin, for not less than (5) nor more than twenty (20) days, or by both such forfeiture and imprisonment.

This ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit the hunting of migratory water fowl with due care, in compliance with Federal and State laws and regulations, during the open season thereof.
