ORDINANCE NO. 94- 2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRANSPORT INTO AND DEPOSIT OF SEWAGE,
GARBAGE, AND REFUSE IN THE TOWN OF MECAN

The Town Board of the Town of Mecan, being duly assembled, do ordain as follows:

1. This ordinance is adopted to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of residents of the Town of Mecan; to protect property values; and to reduce pollution.

2. No person, firm, or corporation shall transport any sewage wastes, septic tank materials, effluent, garbage, or rubbish into the Town of Mecan, without first obtaining a permit therefore from the Town Board.

3. The term "transport" as used herein shall encompass conveyance of such materials into the Town of Mecan by truck, pipeline, or in any other manner. The terms "rubbish" and "garbage" shall be given their usual and commonly accepted meaning.

4. This ordinance does not apply to the transport of materials through the Town of Mecan, where such materials are not left or deposited within the borders of the Township.

5. Such permit may be issued by the Town Board, upon payment of a fee of \$250.00 per year, only at a public meeting, and subject to such restrictions as the Town Board may impose to carry out the intention of this ordinance.

6. Violation of this ordinance shall result in a forfeiture of \$250.00 per day, together with the costs of prosecution. Each day such violation exists shall be considered a separate offense.
