WHEREAS, The Town Of Mekan, does hereby recognize State Law (s.66.0509(1m), Wis Stat.) ACT 10. and


WHEREAS, The Town of Mekan has adopted the following Grievance Procedure this Day of August 11th, 2011. And this Grievance Procedure will placed in the towns permanent record book.

1. If the employee is a union employee, he/she must bring their grievance to their union steward. Then the union employee and their grievance person must bring the grievance before the Town of Mekan Board of Supervisors. If the grievant and the board of supervisors cannot resolve the dispute, then the Town of Mekan and the grievant will go before a State certified arbitrator. At this time the grievant and the Town of Mekan will deposit \$1000.00 in a special account for the start up cost of this arbitration. The arbitrators decision will be the final decision of the grievance. The looser of the grievance will pay all costs of the grievance.
2. If the employee is not a union employee the process will be the same as above less the union involvement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town of Mekan, Marquette County, Wisconsin does hereby recognize this Grievance Procedure as the Towns Grievance Procedure in compliance with the State Of Wisconsin ACT 10. State law (s.66.0509(1m), Wis Stat.)


