RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-2000

Relating to the decline of enforcement of the UDC.

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mekan, Marquette County, Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting held on the 11th day of April, 2000, does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 101.651 (2m) (b), WI Stats., provides that municipalities of 2500 or less population that do not want enforcement of the Uniform Dwelling Code for one and two-family dwellings, shall pass a resolution to that effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Mekan shall not:

- \* exercise jurisdiction over the construction and inspection of new one-and 2-family dwellings under s. 101.65(1)(a),
- \* exercise jurisdiction jointly with another municipality under s. 101.65(1)(b),
- \* request under sub. 101.65(3)(a) that a county enforce this subchapter or an ordinance enacted under s. 101.65(1)(a) throughout the municipality.
- \* request under sub. 101.65(3)(a) that a county provide inspection services in the municipality to administer and enforce this subchapter or an ordinance enacted under s. 101.65(1)(a).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution will be sent to the Wisconsin Division of Safety & Buildings and the Marquette County Zoning Administrator.
