RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-2001

Relating to the land ownership transfer between the Town and Carol & Craig Hamberger.

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Mekan, Marquette County, Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting held on the 15th day of November 2001, does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, Craig And Carol Hamberger, approached the Board requesting that we exchange small portions of our land, which would help to square up the Town property and their surrounding land. Said transfer would slightly increase the total lot size of the Town.

WHEREAS, the Hamberger's would then donate a sizeable portion of land (approximately 30,000 sq. ft.) to the west of the Town property and including a 10-foot wide piece along the rear (south side) of the Town property. The donation is to provide a parking lot for the Church, which is located across the street.

WHEREAS, the transfer improves the Town Hall property and also increases the size of the property, therefore, it seems proper to consider their request.

WHEREAS, the transfer has previously come before the Board and has been accepted by a motion, duly made and seconded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Mekan shall:

Transfer to the Hambergers a wedge of land on the south side of the property as indicated on the enclosed drawing by Knight Land Surveying.

Accept in return a wedge of land on the west side of the property as indicated on the enclosed drawing by Knight Land Surveying.


Allow the Hambergers to file with the Register of Deeds all necessary paper work that is required by law.


