UNIFORM DWELLING CODE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin, on December 18th, 2003 signed into law the Home Safety Act, and

WHEREAS, this law removes the exemption of enforcement of the Uniform Dwelling Code for municipalities of 2,500 population or less, and

WHEREAS, the removal of this exemption would require the Town to either hire a building inspector, delegate the program to Marquette County, or allow the State of Wisconsin to administer the program on behalf of the Town and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mecan recognizes, in the interest of it's contractors, landowners and constituents the importance of local administration of the program and enforcing the program in a consistent and uniform manner throughout Marquette County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Town Board of the Town of Mecan do hereby agree to delegate the administration and enforcement of the Uniform Dwelling Code of the State of Wisconsin to Marquette County
