Nicole stated that she will be working with Brandon to figure out what needs to be updated. Caroline stated that we need the old web site able to be viewed. Citizen comments; Katie Schueller recently moved to the area and wanted to know if there was a way to lower the speed limit on her road. Stated that there is a 25 mile speed limit sign posted near the boat ramp. Katie was advised that due to the cost and what it would take to change there is most likely not enough traffic on the road to lower the speed. Chairman Mike Raddatz said he would look into it. Monitoring is expensive and we monitored Fox CT. We were not allowed to lower the speed limit on Fox CT. which is the most highly traveled township road.
